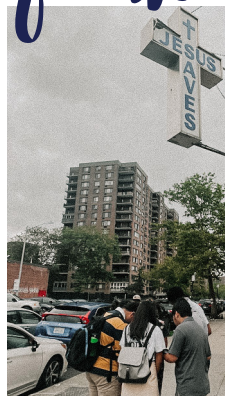

110 kids joined Summer Camp

56 families participated in the Easter egg hunt

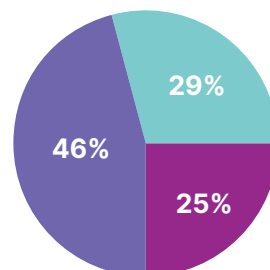

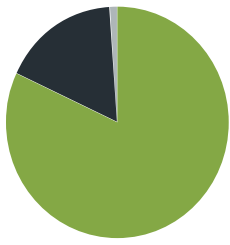

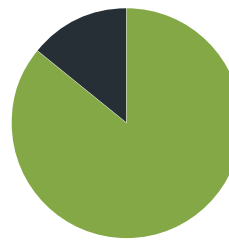

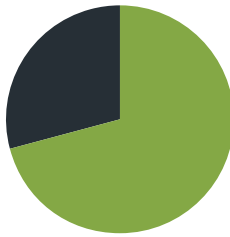
Revenue: \$3,229,595

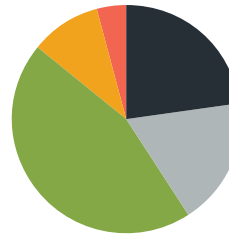
Expenses: \$2,957,422

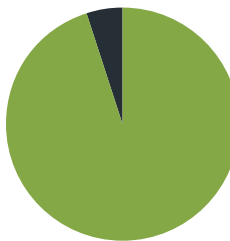
Local Ministry Fund Giving: \$2,650,540

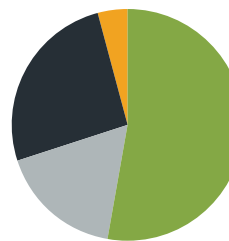
